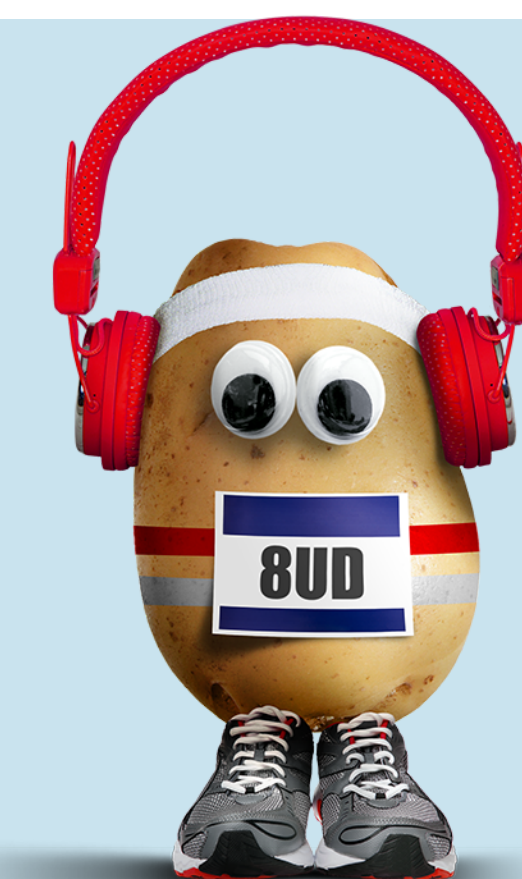


Our latest snacks are made with some of our favourite breakfast items! Here are some activities to make the most of your leftover cereal boxes!

YOUR ACTIVITY

KS1

Activity for KS1:

- Cut out the front and back of your cereal box to provide you with a canvas
- Using paint or crayons you can create a garden setting. Using blue for the sky and green for grass.
- Use the glue to stick the twigs and other objects you found in your garden or whilst walking to create flowers.
- Use a handful of your cereal to stick close to the twigs and create leaves.
- Use things you found in your garden, or leftover cardboard to add other objects to your design. You could add a fence, birds or some clouds!

KS2

Activity KS2:

- Using the leftover parts of your cereal box you could get more creative and design some flowers with your cardboard.
- Paint or colour the flowers to brighten up your design!
