

SUNSHINE & SHADOWS

- Pencil
- Rubber
- Toothpick/small stick
- Coloured pens and/or pencils
- Paper
- Random objects from around the house (tins, fruit, veg, boxs, jars.... anything!)



ACTIVITIES

<u>SUITABLE FOR BOTH KS1 AND KS2</u>

Activity 1: Put a toothpick or small stick in a rubber in the middle of a piece of paper. Put it out in the garden or in a sunny spot by the window. Draw the shadows at every hour of the day, labelling the time.

- What do you think will happen to the shadows?
- What do you notice about the direction of the shadows over the day?

Activity 2: Using objects from around the kitchen and house, build a shape that looks like a SUPERHERO. Then place your design by the window. Trace its shadow on a piece of paper. Then colour it in and give it a name!

EXTRA KS2 ACTIVITY

Activity 3: Can you lable different parts of your Superheroes body? Where is their mouth, stomach, digestive system, tongue, legs and feet?
