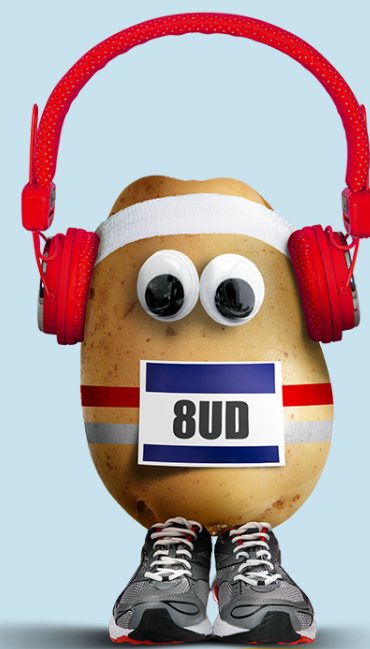


With SUNSHINE comes SHADOWS! Our Superheroes are going to challenge you to create your own superhero shadow using bits and bobs from around the house....

SUITABLE FOR BOTH KS1 AND KS2

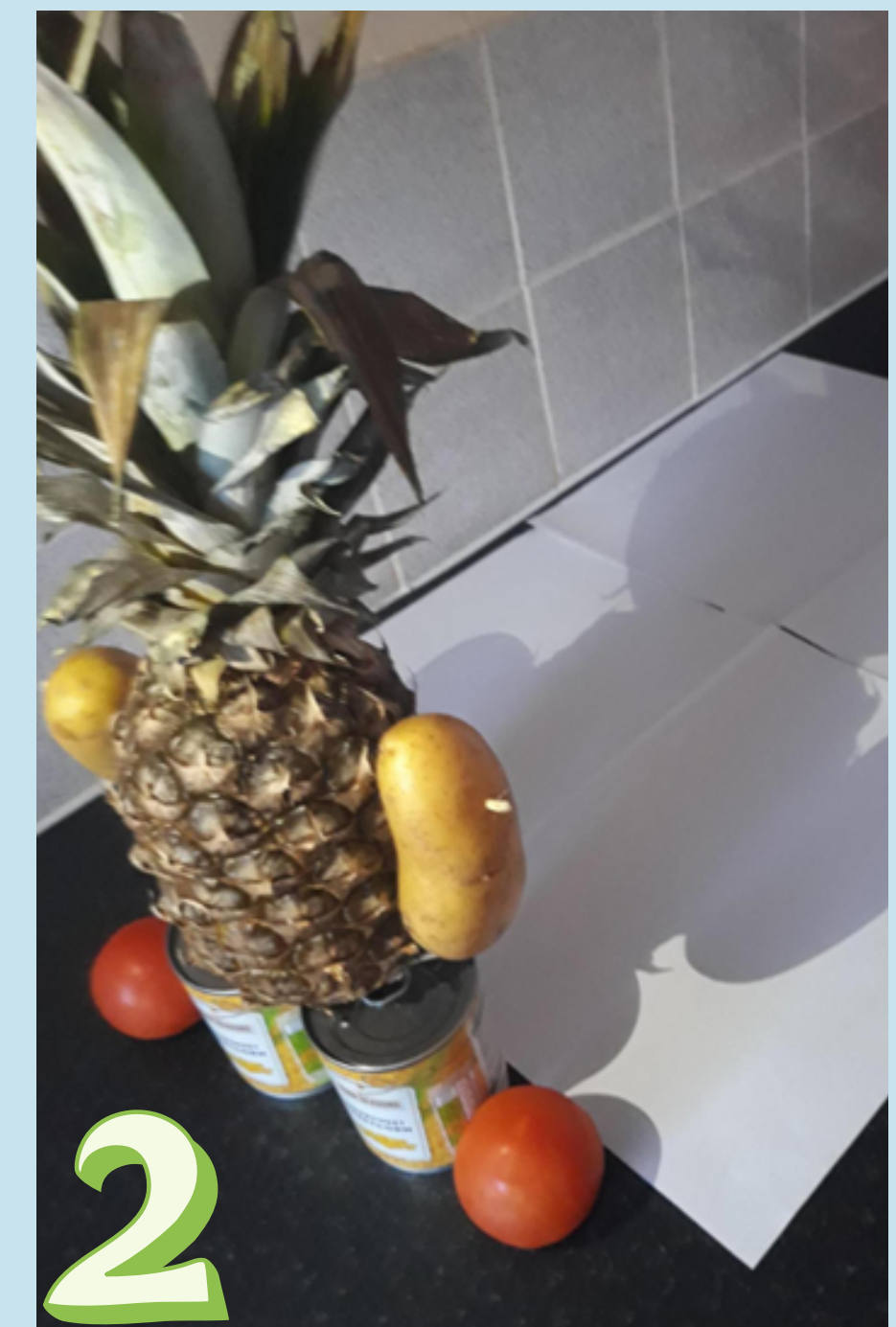
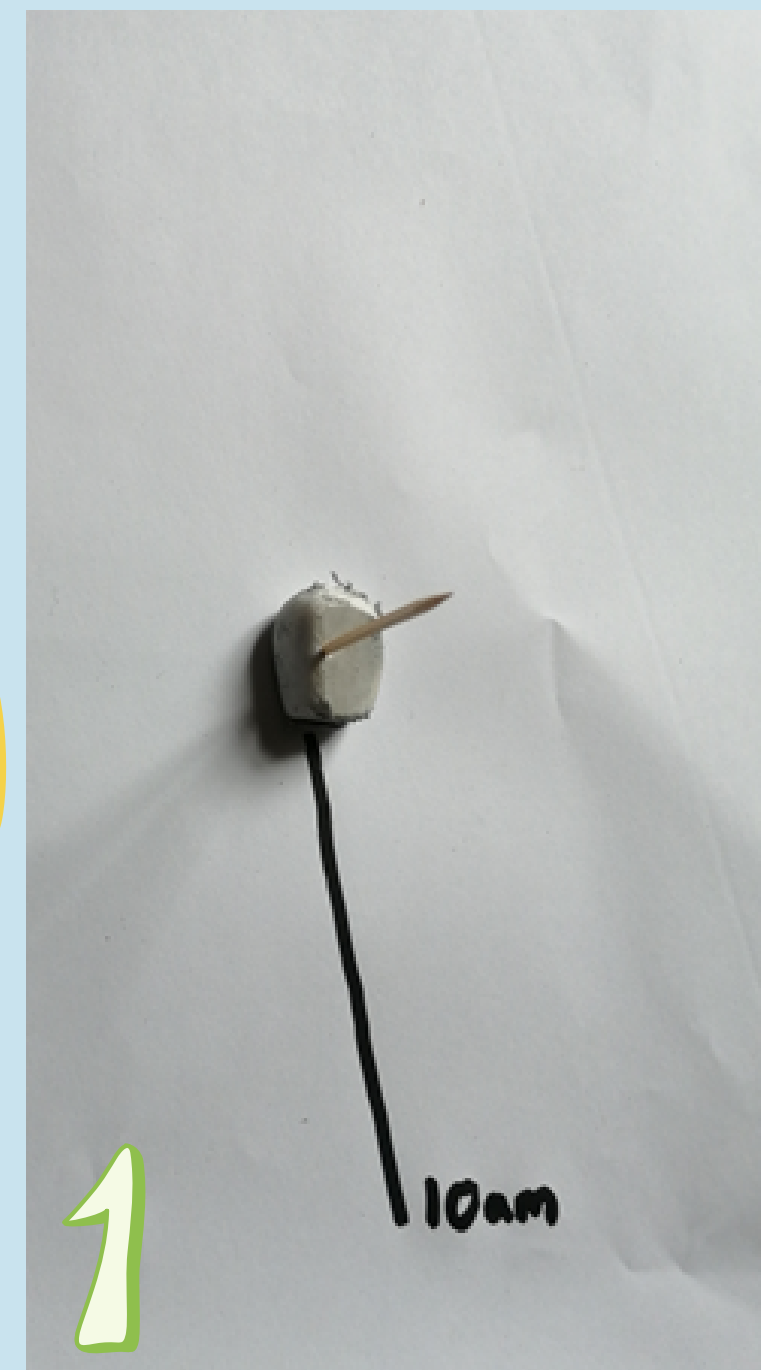
Activity 1: Put a toothpick or small stick in a rubber in the middle of a piece of paper. Put it out in the garden or in a sunny spot by the window. Draw the shadows at every hour of the day, labelling the time.

- What do you think will happen to the shadows?
- What do you notice about the direction of the shadows over the day?

Activity 2: Using objects from around the kitchen and house, build a shape that looks like a SUPERHERO. Then place your design by the window. Trace its shadow on a piece of paper. Then colour it in and give it a name!

Activity 3: Can you label different parts of your Superheroes body? Where is their mouth, stomach, digestive system, tongue, legs and feet?
